Russell Triplett-Head Coach

Head baseball coach Russell Triplett completed his 14th season at Newberry College after a four year stint as head assistant/recruiting coordinator at USC-Upstate, and an Assistant at Clemson for a year and a half. In 2019 and 2023, Triplett led the Wolves to the best seasons in program history. His team won 41 games while winning the SAC Regular season Conference Championship both years while also winning the SAC Tournament Championship in 2023. In 2019 and 2023 his teams not only made the NCAA tournament but were selected as a “Host” site. Triplett was named the SAC Coach of the Year and Newberry Male Coach of the Year for the third time in his career in 2023. A four-year letterman at Clemson, Triplett a former two time all-ACC player, led the Tigers to four NCAA Regional appearances, two Super-Regional appearances and an appearance in the 2002 College World Series. He also appeared in the 2006 College World Series as an Asst Coach at Clemson. Triplett played with the New York Mets Organization reaching the AA level.

Jay Snyder – Associate Head Coach

Jay Snyder completed his 16th season at Newberry College. In 2014 Snyder was promoted to Associate Head Coach. Coach Snyder began his coaching career at Keystone College in PA where he helped guide the Giants to 4 Conference Titles, 2 ECAC Titles, 32 All Conference players and saw 6 of his players sign Professional Contracts.

Gordie Theisen – Pitching Coach

Gordie Theisen completed his 1st season at Newberry College. Theisen is no stranger to coaching at the collegiate level, spending his first 16 years as the head coach for Siena Heights. He was inducted into the Siena Heights Hall of Fame in 2021. Gordie was a pitching coach at 3 other colleges, most notably coaching with his son at Hillsdale College where together they set multiple school records while also making 2 NCAA Regionals and capturing a GMAC tournament championship. While at Adrian College he coached three straight MIAA Pitchers of the Year, from 2009-11, and Adrian had a staff earned run average of 2.56 in 2011, 2nd in all of NCAA Division III.

Ian Clements – Assistant Coach

Ian Clements completed his 7th season at Newberry College and 1st as an assistant coach. Coach Clements was a 5-year starter behind the plate. Clements was an integral piece of the success the Wolves had during his time at “The Berry” both as a player and as a leader in the program. Ian was a part of Newberry winning the first-ever South Atlantic Conference as well as setting the school record for wins in a season going 41-16. Clements brings value to the Wolves program with his energy, leadership, and the ability to develop catchers.

Session

The camp will run from 9:00 AM until 12:00 PM daily Monday thru Thursday. Check-in will be held Monday morning at the Smith Road Complex.

Enrollment

Enrollment will be on a “first come” basis and will be limited to the first 100 campers that apply. Make certain you tell us what your primary/secondary positions are so we can balance the teams properly.

Deposit

The deposit will be full tuition of \$125.00

Newly renovated Smith Road Complex (one of the best playing surfaces in the state of South Carolina) on the campus of Newberry College will host this year’s Youth Camp.

Inclement Weather

If there is inclement weather, the Camp will be moved inside and will become a combination Camp/Clinic due to limited indoor facilities. All campers should dress appropriately (cool weather) for outdoor camp.

***Every effort will be made to have the camp outside.**

The camp will be open to any child age 6 – 12. Participants will be grouped by grade.
